

## Prof. dr. Dimitrij Rupel - Curriculum Vitae

Dimitrij Rupel holds a PhD in Sociology from Brandeis University. He is a full professor, former Minister of Foreign Affairs of Slovenia (1990–1992, 2000–2008), former Ambassador to the United States (1997–2000), and the author of numerous books and articles on international relations and foreign policy. He has lectured at the University of Ljubljana, the New School for Social Research, Cleveland State University, and many other universities around the world.

Professor Dimitrij Rupel has published extensively on political and diplomatic issues. He is the author of many works of fiction, social science, and books dealing with international affairs. His personal experience of the Slovenian Spring is described in his book *Skrivnost države (The Secret of the State, 1992)*. In more recent years, he published a detailed report on Slovenia's Presidency of the European Union (*Slovensko predsedovanje v ognju lastnih sil, 2009*), a comprehensive overview of Slovenian diplomacy (*Slovenija na svetovnem prizorišču, Slovenia on the World Stage, 2011*), and an analysis of the Slovenian national movement from the May Declaration of 1917 to independence and transition (*Negotovo življenje 176. članice OZN, The Uncertain Life of the 176th Member of the UN, 2013*).

Dimitrij Rupel currently lectures at the Faculty of Government and European Studies and at the European Faculty of Law.
