Cilji:

- Poznavanje kulturnega in političnega položaja slovenske skupnosti oz. Slovenije od Ilirskega provinca do neodvisne države;
- Kritična zavest o razvoju slovenske državne in nacionalne zavesti v kontekstu mednarodnih odnosov;
- Razumevanje sodobnih evropskih in globalnih procesov;
- Razumevanje izzivov slovenske zunanje politike.

Kompetence:

Pričujoči predmet prispeva k razvoju naslednjih splošnih in specifičnih kompetenc študentov :

- poznavanje in razumevanje diplomatskih in mednarodnopravnih pojmov;

- Understanding challenges the Slovenian foreign policy is faced with.

The present subject contributes to the development of following generic and specific competences of students:

- development of critical thinking in addressing the fundamental issues, processes and problems of the international community;
- ability to transition from a descriptive approach/learning/understanding of issues to analytical

Prispeval naj bi k poznavanju diplomatske zgodovine Slovenije, njenega mednarodnega položaja in njenih nacionalnih interesov, upoštevajoč tudi kontekst aktualne mednarodne agende.

Študijski uspeh bo povezan s predhodnim znanjem tujih jezikov, evropske in slovenske zgodovine, osnov mednarodnih odnosov in z mednarodno razgledanostjo.

Predavatelj študentom priporoča, da si pred vsakokratnimi predavanji preberejo nekatera besedila z zgornjega seznama, da bi se seznanili z ozadjem in teorijo o zunanji politiki, evropskih zadevah in geopolitiki.

b) Specific competences

Students should acquire competences and skills to work in the civil service, including in institutions with international contacts and responsibilities.

The course is intended to contribute to students' general education, to their ability to speak competently in public and to their ability to think analytically and critically about international relations. It is also intended to contribute to knowledge of Slovenia's diplomatic history, to the ability of students to understand the international position of the Republic of Slovenia and its national interests, also in the context of the actual policy-making agenda.

Academic success will be linked to prior knowledge of foreign languages, European and Slovenian history, the basics of international relations and an international outlook.

To help provide some background and theory on foreign policy, European affairs and geopolitics students are encouraged to look at some of the texts on the above reading list in advance of taking the class.
