Vsebina:

Content (Syllabus outline):

Predmet je nadaljevalna oblika dodiplomskega predmeta ustavno pravo. Njegov prvci cilj je študenta poglobljeno seznaniti s temeljnim pojmom ustavne demokracije kot seštevka demokracije in vladavine prava. Drugi cilj pa razviti sposobnost kritičnega vrednotenja stanja ustavne demokracije v Sloveniji ter razvoja lastnih ustvarjalnih idej za njeno izboljšanje.

Ker se predmet izvaja v okviru Jean Monnet katedre, projekta, ki ga sofinancira Evropska komisija, bodo vsi vsebinski sklopi predmeta posvečeni tudi analizi problematike pluralizma v Evropski uniji.

Predmet je sestavljen iz 3 širokih vsebinskih sklopov:

1. Demokracija in vladavina prava
2. Konstitutivne pravice demokratične in pravne države
3. Krize ustavne demokracije in možne rešitve
4. Pluralizem v evropskem ustavnem prostoru in še posebej v EU

The course is an advanced version of undergraduate course on Constitutional Law. It has two principal objectives. First, to provide an in-depth knowledge of constitutional democracy as 'a paradoxical concept of contradictory principles: the rule of law and democracy'. Second, to foster the capacity of critical normative evaluation of the state of constitutional democracy in Slovenia and beyond, as well as developing of new creative ideas for the improvement of the current state of affairs.

As the course is conducted as part of the Jean Monnet Chair, a project awarded and co-funded by the European Commission, the entire course will be pervaded by the focus on a problematique of pluralism in the European Union.

The course consists of three major parts:

1. Democracy and the rule of law
2. Constitutive rights of democracy and the rule of law
3. Crisis of a constitutional democracy and possible solutions.
4. Pluralism in the European constitutional space, with a special focus on the European Union.

- poznavanje in razumevanje problematike pluralizma v evropskem ustavnem prostoru;
- razumevanje pomembnosti uporabe ustavnih načel za delovanje demokratične in pravne države in razvoj sposobnosti dostopati do domače in tuje sodne prakse;
- razumevanje in sposobnost uporabe temeljnih vrednot slovenskega ustavnega reda (človekovo dostojanstvo, pluralizem, svoboda, enakost in solidarnost) v praksi;
- sposobnost samostojnega in avtonomnega študijskega dela;
- razvoj sposobnosti kritično analizirati pravne vire in pravna besedila;
- kritična refleksija obstoječih pravnih virov in ocena njihove potrebnosti in kakovosti;
- sposobnost uporabe načel pravne države, vladavine prava in ustavne demokracije v praksi;
- sposobnost kritične strokovne razprave in analize o temeljnih pojmi, načelih in pravil ustavnega prava
- razumevanje in sposobnost ocene kakovosti delovanja institucij demokratične in pravne države
- sposobnost ustreznega navajanja domačih in mednarodnih pravnih virov, domače in mednarodne sodne prakse in elektronskih virov;

- knowledge and understanding of the problematique of pluralism in the European constitutional space;
- understanding the importance of applying constitutional principles to the functioning of a constitutional democracy and developing the capacity to access domestic and foreign jurisprudence;
- understanding and ability to apply the values of the Slovenian constitutional order (human dignity, pluralism, freedom, equality and solidarity) in practice;
- ability to study independently and autonomously;
- developing the ability to critically analyse legal sources and legal texts;
- a critical reflection on existing legal sources and an assessment of their need and quality;
- the application of concepts, principles and legal rules to the resolution of specific cases from constitutional law jurisprudence;
- ability to critically discuss and professionally analyse the fundamental concepts, principles and rules of constitutional democracy;
- understanding and ability to assess the quality of functioning of democratic and rule of law institutions;
- ability to properly cite domestic and international legal sources, domestic and international jurisprudence and electronic resources;

Students will gain the following general competences:

- the use of appropriate methods of legal research, their procedures, analysis and

Dr. Matej Avbelj je redni profesor za evropsko pravo na Fakulteti za državne in evropske študije in nosilec Jean Monnet katedre na Novi univerzi. Doktoriral je na Evropskem univerzitetnem inštitutu v Firencah, magistriral na NYU School of Law in diplomiral na Pravni fakulteti Univerze v Ljubljani. Kot sodniški pripravnik je služboval na Višjem sodišču v Ljubljani, praktične izkušnje pa je nabiral tudi v Evropskem parlamentu kot Robert Schuman stažist v oddelku za ustavne zadeve. Njegovo raziskovanje in akademsko delo je osredotočeno na pravo EU, ustavno pravo in teorijo prava. Aktiven je tudi v stanovskih akademskih in civilnodružbenih iniciativah tako doma kot po svetu.
